Google Student Ambassador Program 2026 Terms & Conditions

PART A: OFFICIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

By accepting selection into the Google Student Ambassador Program 2026 (“Program”), you (“Student Ambassador”, “Participant”, “you”) agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions (“Terms”).

These Terms constitute a legally binding agreement between you and Google India Private Limited (“Google”) and its Program Implementation Partner, Communique Marketing Solutions Private Limited (“Communique”).
